**A Conversation with Alesha Doan about the School/Life  
Balance**

Alesha E. Doan is an Associate Professor in the Political Science Department at the University of Kansas and Chair of the Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies Department. Her research primarily investigates how the political world intersects with reproductive health policy, and often creates obstacles for women that limit their ability to lead healthy and fulfilled lives. Using a range of theoretical approaches and methodological techniques, Professor Doan also examines the central—but typically covert—role of gender, race, and economic inequality in the creation of reproductive and sexual health policies. Her publications include articles in a variety of journals as well as two books. Based on Professor Doan's research, she was selected as the 2012 recipient of the Outstanding Young Professional Award by the Population, Reproductive and Sexual Health Section of the American Public Health Association. She also received the *Woman of Distinction Award*, from the Emily Taylor Center for Women & Gender Equity, University of Kansas in 2013.
