In 2004, Dr. Lunte was the recipient of the AAPS Research Achievement Award in Analysis and Pharmaceutical Quality. She has been an associate editor of Pharm. Sci. and has served on a number of editorial boards including Pharmaceutical Research, Analytical Chemistry, Electrophoresis and The Analyst.*
